### Research in International Economics and Finance - RIEF

The Research in International Economics and Finance (RIEF) network was born in 2004 with the objective to reinforce scientific collaboration and contacts between European research centers working on international economics (either trade, international macro, or international finance). The network organizes a yearly doctoral meeting which offers the opportunity for PhD candidates or young doctors to present their work (should it be in progress or more advanced) to their counterparts and to more confirmed researchers. The first seven meetings were held in Université de Rennes, Université de Paris-Nanterre, Université Libre de Bruxelles, Centre d'Économie de Paris Nord, Université de Genève, and Université de Rennes.

This year's VIII<sup>th</sup> edition is hosted by the **University of Barcelona** on **January 31**<sup>st</sup> **and February 1**<sup>st</sup> **2008**. The two plenary lectures will be given by **Antonio Ciccone** and **Jordi Galí** (CREI-UPF).

Accepted papers will be presented in two series of parallel sessions: one in trade, the other in international macro/finance. Each paper will be discussed by another participant, and submission implies that you are willing to discuss a paper at the meeting.

A prize of 500 euros will be awarded to the best article submitted. To be eligible, all authors (and coauthors) should be PhD students, at least at the time the paper was submitted.

Submitted papers must be sent in electronic format exclusively (pdf format) to Miren Lafourcade (conference secretary: sophie.desalee@cepii.fr) by the 1<sup>st</sup> of November 2007 at the latest.

As for the preceding meetings, there is no submission or participation fee. However, the network will not be able to pay for any travel, accommodation or dinners. Lunch and coffee breaks will be provided by the University at the meeting site.
